RiskWatch SaaS applications are licensed by the annual:

Number of users that will need to access the software or

Number of areas that will be assessed

A **User** is someone that edits data in a RiskWatch application, and an **Area** is anything that is the subject of an assessment, for example a client, facility, supplier, vendor, asset, etc.

To determine how many licenses you will need, you will need to know if you are going to require more **Users** or **Areas**.

For every **User** license you purchase, you will also receive an **Area** License, and vice versa.

Therefor, the number of licenses you will need will be the greater of either the number of **Users** you will have, or the number of **Areas** you will assess (annually).

To the right, in Example 1, if you were going to have 10 **Users** of the software and assess 20 **Areas**, you would need 20 licenses to accommodate your **Areas** requirements.

In, Example 2, the scenario is reversed. Twenty **Users** will need to access the software, but only 10 **Areas** will be assessed. Again, you would need 20 licenses. This time to accommodate your **Users** requirements
